Alcohol definitions

| 1 | alcopop | A pre-mixed alcoholic drink |
|----|------------|---------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| 2 | bubbly | Champagne |
| 3 | cask | A cardboard box with plastic lining and a small tap, used to hold and serve wine |
| 4 | cleanskin | Cheap, unbranded wine |
| 5 | keg | A small cask or barrel, usually holding 20-40 litres (often beer) |
| 6 | light/lite | Low in alcohol |
| 7 | mixer | A beverage such as cola, juice, or soda water that can be combined with liquor to produce a mixed drink |
| 8 | mocktail | A non-alcoholic cocktail |
| 9 | nip/shot | A small serve of spirits |
| 10 | plonk | Wine (usually cheap and/or poor quality) |
| 11 | six-pack | Half a dozen bottles or cans of beer |
| 12 | slab | A carton of 24 cans or bottles of beer |
| 13 | spirits | Undiluted distilled alcohol |
| 14 | stubbie | A short glass bottle for beer (330-375 ml) |
